



SMOKING AND FIRE RESTRICTION ORDER

This Order regarding Smoking and Fire Restrictions within the City of Durango is entered by the City Manager on May 26, 2022, pursuant to the provisions of Emergency Ordinance 2022-17 as approved by the City Council of the City of Durango on May 17, 2022.

Effective immediately, it is Ordered as follows:

1. FIRE RESTRICTIONS

- a. All open fires or any kind or the burning of any material of any kind on public or private property within the City is prohibited. This restriction shall not prohibit the use of charcoal or gas barbeque grills at private residences.
- b. Using explosive material of any kind, including but not limited to, fireworks, blasting caps, or any incendiary device which may result in the ignition of flammable material within the City is prohibited.

2. SMOKING RESTRICTIONS

Smoking, as defined in Section 21-111 of the Durango City Code, except within an enclosed vehicle or building, or while stopped in an area that is at least 3 feet in diameter that is barren or cleared of all flammable vegetation. Smoking continues to be prohibited in those public spaces described in Section 21-112 of the Durango City Code.

The City will attempt to seek voluntary compliance through education and warning notices prior to the issuance of any citations. Violations of this Order are subject to the penalties set forth in Emergency Ordinance 2022-17.

This Smoking and Fire Restriction Order shall remain in effect until modified or revoked by further Order of the City Manager.
